He also reread Shakespeare's complete works in his late 70s His wife was a retired teacher and community volunteer. A graduate of the Bryn Mawr School with a degree in early-childhood education from Vassar College. During WW II she worked at a day care center for the children of defense workers. She taught at the Park School in Baltimore and served for more than 50 years as a volunteer at Planned Parenthood and also served on their board. Active in the League of Women Voter of Baltimore and the Johns Hopkins Club. She was a voracious speed reader.*^{1041,1042}
